From Our Chair MYRNA MEYER

Our goal is ensuring that every visitor to the Museum – whether in person or on our website – has an eye-opening, empowering experience. Making that happen takes passion, purpose and people.

It wasn't until I began visiting other Holocaust museums and viewing their websites that I realized just how unique we are when it comes to the people part of that equation.

I'd like to use this column to shine the spotlight on the individuals who enable the Museum to run so smoothly and accomplish so much.

We are fortunate to have four outstanding professionals to guide us:

- Jean Cavender, Director
- Dan Reich, Curator and Director of Education
- Andrew Goldfeder, Manager of Programs and Logistics
- Diane Everman, Archivist, St. Louis Community Archives

Their deep knowledge, myriad of talents and boundless energy are invaluable. But they would be the first to acknowledge that our volunteers make it possible to open our doors six days a week, conduct more than 750 tours each year and sustain an award-winning operation.

Incredibly, we have more than 100 people who freely give their time to our cause. They include Holocaust survivors and their relatives who bring history to life by sharing their own experiences or those of loved ones.

Each spring, our Yom HaShoah, or Holocaust Remembrance, event attracts upwards of 800 people to a memorable and moving program planned by volunteers.

Every summer, volunteer educators craft workshops that help teachers more effectively explore the causes and lessons of the Holocaust in classrooms across the region.

Others shape our fundraising activities, oversee facilities planning, help with marketing and shepherd our oral history project that has captured on tape the experiences of more than 100 area Holocaust survivors who immigrated to our community.

Dozens serve as docents, leading tours for approximately 20,000 students each year and 3,000 adults who book tours or discover us on the internet while vacationing in St. Louis. Still more volunteers organize programs that attract another 4,000 visitors to lectures, exhibits, films and arts events. Much of this work is coordinated by members of 12 ongoing volunteer committees. Some of these individuals have been associated with the Museum since it opened in 1995, while others joined our effort as our needs grew.

Our work has attracted attention. FamilyLivingToday.com named the Museum one of the top 25 places to visit in St. Louis. The National Conference for Community and Justice of Metropolitan St. Louis is honoring us with an award for work that exemplifies positive change for diversity, inclusion and equity.

As I mentioned, I've had a chance to visit other Holocaust museums in person and online. While numbers alone don't tell the full story, when I hear about facilities that welcome half as many visitors yet have a much larger paid staff, I'm incredibly proud of what we've been able to accomplish.

I hope you will join me in honoring our staff, volunteers and hundreds of donors who have helped to make this an amazing institution.

Mother's Cross Given to the HMLC Archives

The Reich rewarded German women with a Mother's Cross of Honor annually on the second Sunday in May (Mother's Day). Mothers were awarded the cross if they were ethnic Germans and "deemed worthy" by producing at least four children for the Reich. Crosses came in three levels depending on the number of children a mother bore: gold for eight or more, silver for six or seven and bronze for four or five children. The awards came in two sizes, a large one with a neck ribbon for grand occasions and a miniature that could be worn every day. Women wearing such emblems received preferential treatment and public services, everything from having front row seats at an event and moving to the front of lines to the best choices of products and foodstuffs. Below is an edited version of a letter that we received accompanying a gold Mother's Cross. The donor wished to remain anonymous, but the letter was so powerful we felt it was important to publish it in our newsletter to give our readers an idea about the spirit in which this artifact was given to HMLC.



1/15/2018

Dear Mam or Sir!

I was raised in Germany – born in Ober Pommern/Berlin and raised in Baden Wurttemberg. My grandparents were Lina Ott, born November 20, 1902 and Ludwig Ott, born January 20, 1899. The Mother's Cross was given to women after they had their eighth child. Hitler's kinder. All of the women in my family and town had many children.

My grandfather was a hard and hateful man. Ludwig Ott and his Nazi gang. He ran the town and everybody was afraid of him. In 2016 my brother sent the Cross to me. I had no idea what I was holding or what it represented. The Cross was given to my grandmother, and my grandmother gave it to my mom after she had her eighth child.

My brother told me some of what he knew. I began looking up everything I could find on my computer. I ordered books and movies. Now I understand a lot more, and I got angry, ashamed and felt terribly guilty. My family never ever talked about any of this. As a child I always knew something evil was in my grandparent's home. The hardship, pain and loss of innocent life of children, women and men. Families lost all in the name of one evil man, in the name of White Power, and nobody stopped him until it was too late.

The more I learned about the Holocaust victims' horror, the more my heart broke, the more I felt ashamed and the angrier I got.

I showed my grandchildren and children the Cross. We had a conversation about it. I told them now you know about the bad side of your family. It's your responsibility to see that it will never be forgotten or ever happen again.

I always told my children and grandchildren to be kind to each other and to others. Everybody has a life story that they struggle with.

I will feel better, and thank you, for taking the Cross and using it as a teaching tool and it will never be glorified.

I had a sweet friend as a child, her name was Resle. One day the whole family was gone. The next day my uncle moved into their house. I asked my grandmother if she knew where Resle was. My grandfather came over and hit me in the face. He yelled at me to never speak of her again. I was locked in the basement for hours.

Today I know what happened to my friend Resle and her family. I pray they are out there happy. She is still in my heart. I cry and hurt for the innocent victims of the Holocaust.

We can't ever forget. We have to tell the story to the younger generation. There is still so much evil out in the world.

Thank you again.

Sawyer Bland's Bar Mitzvah Project

"I want to thank all of you for being a part of my Bar Mitzvah project at the Holocaust Museum. I hope all of you learn something today as you walk through the tour. I first wanted to do this project when a Holocaust survivor named Mendel Rosenberg spoke at my synagogue. He told our group that the reason he keeps telling people his story is for one reason. 'So that no one forgets about what happened and so that it won't happen again.' Mendel is going to share his story with us again today and we are very lucky to have him here to speak about something that is very difficult to talk about and very difficult to hear. Finally, I wanted to say thank you to everyone who made a donation to the Holocaust Museum. The Museum is a non-profit organization, so they are able to exist due to the generosity of the community. My goal was to raise \$250 in donations and match this amount, to donate \$500. I'm excited to say that we will be donating \$818, due to everyone's generosity. Oral History Website To Be Launched Over The Summer

HMLC is pleased to announce that very soon you will be able to listen to testimonies given by survivors who immigrated to the St. Louis community. The Vida "Sister" Prince Oral History Project, now in its thirty ninth year, has been staffed by "Sister" Prince who has graciously volunteered her time to secure these precious interviews.

"Sister" did the majority of these interviews on a cassette tape recorder, as that was the technology of the time, when the project began. A few years ago HMLC invested dollars to preserve the interviews on these tapes by digitizing them. Andrew Goldfeder, manager of programs and logistics, stated "We boxed up more than four hundred cassette tapes and sent them to Philadelphia to experts in the field of audio tape digitization." The company, George Blood and Associates, transferred all the interviews to a hard drive thus preserving them for the next generation of museum attendees. Enter website designers Wired Impact, who submitted a proposal describing how they would be able to put those testimonies on our website and open the project to the public in a way that made these priceless interviews more accessible than ever. Our thanks to "Sister" Prince who very generously funded the project. The testimonies will have photos of the families and in most cases are accompanied by written transcriptions. There were many Holocaust survivors who chose not to speak publicly about their experiences because it was just too painful. "Sister" managed to get them to tell her about their experiences and record their words so that others may learn.

Annual Yom HaShoah Commemoration

The 2018 community-wide Yom HaShoah Holocaust Commemoration was held on April 15 and hosted by United Hebrew Congregation. The theme of the program this year was "#WeRemember: to honor the past and protect our future." The #WeRemember campaign is an educational social media initiative focusing on the Holocaust and the dangers of anti-Semitism and xenophobia. In addition to the Holocaust Torah procession, candle-lighting ceremony, music and liturgical readings and prayers, the Commemoration focused on Holocaust testimony and honored the Holocaust survivors in our community. Michelle Drabin chaired the Yom HaShoah committee and the program was generously supported by Leo and Sara Wolf* and the Wolf family.

Janusz Korczak Text Panel Added to HMLC Permanent Exhibit



The HMLC recently added a text panel focusing on Janusz Korczak to its permanent exhibit. An internationally recognized expert on childrearing, and director of an orphanage in the Warsaw ghetto, Korczak rejected opportunities to gain his own freedom and chose to die with "his children" in Treblinka. Coupled with images of partisans and ghetto fighters, Korczak's self-sacrifice represents another form of resistance – that of the spirit.

Vida “Sister” Prince Publication Accepted at the Smithsonian

In 2013, Vida Prince published a book entitled *That's The Way It Was: Stories of Struggle, Survival and Self-Respect in Twentieth Century Black St. Louis*. Years ago, “Sister” Prince embarked on a project interviewing members of the African American community about what life was like for them in St. Louis during the 1930s through the early 1960s. Published by The History Press, “Sister” writes in her introduction, “The oral histories paint a portrait of how parents and children interacted with one another as they faced the pervasiveness of racism in their daily lives and how parents coped with the dilemma of protecting their children from the harsh lessons of that world while at the same time preparing them to live with what they had learned.” Earlier this year, “Sister” received a letter announcing the following:

“The Smithsonian Institution has graciously accepted the book, *That's The Way It Was*, by Mrs. Vida Prince. The book will be housed in the library collections of the Smithsonian Anacostia Community Museum Library in Washington, D.C. The museum is dedicated to the research, documentation and interpretation of urban contemporary communities and issues. Your generosity helps to achieve this goal, and is very much appreciated by all of us.”

Spinning for Good

When Lory Cooper won a private party at Cyclebar, an indoor spinning and cycling franchise with a location in Creve Coeur, she started brainstorming some ideas to make the event a fundraiser. “I wanted to do something that was meaningful to me,” said Cooper, 30, who is the Youth Program Supervisor at the Jewish Community Center.

That’s when she decided to merge her two passions: fitness and the St. Louis Holocaust Museum & Learning Center (HMLC).

“I realize the two don’t necessarily fit together, but I am crazy about both fitness and the Holocaust Museum, and I wanted to share those passions with my family and friends,” added Cooper.

She held the party on Dec. 7, explaining that for every rider who came, she would make a donation to the HMLC, where she is a docent and leads tours. She also invited guests to join her for a private tour of the Museum a few days later, which would be followed by a brunch at Kohn’s Kosher Meat and Deli Restaurant. Cooper is the granddaughter of the late Bobbie and Simon Kohn, who started the restaurant in 1963. The elder Kohns were Holocaust survivors who met after being liberated from the Auschwitz extermination camp.

Cooper said about 40 people attended that party, and she wound up raising \$867 for the Museum. About a third of those who came also donated – “I did my best to guilt them into it,” she joked.

Cooper is aware that at 30, she is likely the youngest docent at the Museum.

“I went to the Holocaust Museum benefit at the Ritz in August (2015) and saw the montage video they had done. I decided then I wanted to be a docent,” said Cooper, who explained that her grandfather never spoke about the Holocaust, though her grandmother did.

“It was always...not quite real. I knew they were survivors and I knew six million Jews were killed, but I never put it together as a kid.”

Cooper said that while in college at Northwestern University, she took a class about women in the Holocaust. For an assignment, she compared a story she read in class to her grandmother’s experience.

“My professor believed that women suffered more in the Holocaust because the Nazis hated Jewish women since they were the bearers of Jewish children,” said Cooper, noting that others disagree with that assessment. “I was watching my grandmother’s video, done in the 1990s by the Shoah Foundation, where she talked about her mother holding a cousin’s baby while the cousin went to get a diaper. The Nazis saw my grandmother’s mother holding the baby and sent her to the line that went to the gas chamber. That was the last time my grandmother saw her mother. That’s when the whole thing connected and got very real to me. I started sobbing in the library.”
