Holocaust Museum and Learning Center

WHEREAS, the Holocaust Museum and Learning Center is a critical inspiration to motivate St. Louisans to stand up to hatred and bigotry, locally and around the world; and

WHEREAS, last week we commemorated the 75th anniversary of the liberation of the Auschwitz concentration camp, a site of horrific genocide and crimes against humanity and against the Jewish people, rooted in baseless hatred; and

WHEREAS, the Anti-Defamation League recorded the second- and third-highest years on record for anti-Semitic incidents in the United States in 2017 and 2018, which included mass murder, physical assaults, vandalism, and attacks on Jewish institutions; and
