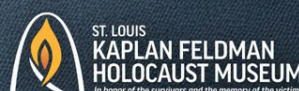

The St. Louis Kaplan Feldman Holocaust Museum's newest special exhibition lands on July 17, 2025. Stay tuned for more information.



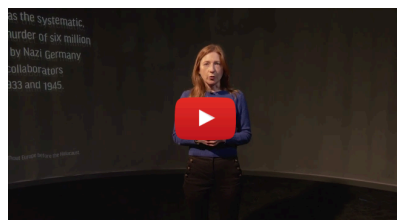

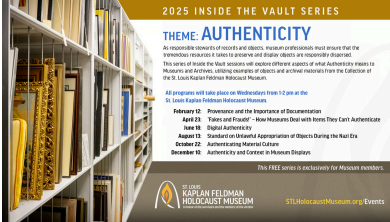
